### \_\_\_\_\_ 1; ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP

Active membership shall be restricted to individuals who are Chief Enforcement Officers of Municipal Building Departments and State Agencies enforcing State Building regulations and to employees of any government department or bureau engaged in the administration or formulation of laws or Ordinances, rules or regulation, relating to buildings.

### \_\_\_\_\_ 2; ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

Associate membership shall be restricted to organizations or firms interested in the maintenance, promotion and improvement of the standards of buildings, housing, city planning or zoning, but not directly engaged in the sale of the building materials or equipment or methods of construction, and to individuals representing manufacturers, architects, engineers, general contractors, financial institutions, insurance companies and others engaged in the building industry directly or allied with it or former active members of this Association.

### \_\_\_\_\_ 3; HONORARY MEMBERSHIP

Honorary membership shall be restricted to individuals of distinction who have rendered outstanding service in the furtherance of the, purposes and objectives of the Association. Honorary membership shall be conferred after presentation to the membership of the Association by the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE and approved by a 2/3 majority of the vote of the active members present at any regular or special meeting of the Association. Such Honorary Member's shall retain the rights and privileges of their previous class of membership, if any, and shall be exempt from the payment of any annual dues.

### \_\_\_\_\_ 4; LIFE MEMBERSHIP

Life membership shall be restricted to individuals who have held a position of Enforcement Officer of Municipal Building Departments, or State Agencies enforcing State Building Regulations for a period of at least fifteen (15) years, and who shall have been an active member of the North Dakota Building Officials Association at the time of retirement or release. Retirement or Release as used here shall mean an Enforcement Officer who is no longer active on a full or part time basis as an Enforcement Officer. Life membership shall be conferred after presentation to the membership of the Association, by the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, and approved by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the active members present at any regular or special meeting of the Association. Such Life Members shall retain the rights and privileges of their previous class of membership and shall be exempt from the payment of any annual dues.

### \_\_\_\_\_ 5; STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

Student Membership shall be restricted to students who are enrolled full-time in a post-secondary educational institution within the State of North Dakota; and, who are pursuing a major course of study in architecture, engineering, code enforcement, construction, or a related field. The annual dues for Student membership shall be one-half the amount of regular annual dues as established by the By-Laws of the North Dakota Building Officials Association.
